Overview of HESI Compass

HESI Compass is a virtual NCLEX review course that provides an individualized study plan along with a personal coach who is dedicated to answering student questions, providing guidance, motivation, and course personalization in the final weeks before students take the NCLEX.

Students will take a full HESI Exit Exam to gauge their knowledge and identify areas of weakness. This is called the Launch Exam. After that, they will take two full HESI Exit Exams that mirror the actual NCLEX – one given in the middle and one given at the end of the course – to inform student's digital study plans and let them know where they stand when it comes to passing the NCLEX.

Course materials, aside from the exams, include review modules with self-study questions and testlets, HESI and NGN Case Studies, and customized quizzes to reinforce knowledge and foster the critical thinking and clinical judgment needed to succeed on the NCLEX and in clinical practice.

HESI Compass Implementation Model and Syllabus Resources

HESI Compass is easy to implement into your course and ensures that your students are supported and filling in any gaps in their knowledge prior to graduation and taking the NCLEX exam. Here is the implementation model:

Slack

Slack is the platform you will use to communicate with the HESI Compass coach assigned to your students. Please make sure you're checking the Faculty Channel on Slack frequently. This is where you will receive messages, questions, and weekly course and student updates from your Coach. Course Exam Administration

- As a reminder, if any changes are made to your established due dates, exam dates, or roster, please email HESICompassAdministrator@elsevier.com so we can update our records and share with your Compass Coach.
- HESI Compass Administrators (HCA) order and set up all exams for the HESI Compass (HC) Course on the designated faculty/school administrator's HESI account.
- If your school has multiple HESI Next Generation Assessment Courses, please make sure to specify the correct course ID prior to exam set up.
- HESI Compass exam delivery is a secure process; therefore, these exams must be proctored in person, or you can choose to contract with ProctorU for remote proctoring service.
- All Exam changes, including date changes, makeup exams, extended testing windows, and separate HESI NG Exam Groups for accommodated students, must be communicated to the HESI Compass Team.

FAQs

How do students and faculty access the HESI Compass course? The HESI Compass course is set up like other courses in the faculty and student's Evolve accounts. Both faculty and students will receive an email when their Compass course is available in their Evolve accounts.

Do all exams have to be administered on campus? HESI Exams must be administered in a proctored environment. This can be on campus or using an online using a proctor service, for example, Proctor U.

How are the HESI Launch Exam and HESI Exit Exams A & B exams set up? Exams are set up by our team in the customer's HESI Assessment NG Course. After the exams are set up, we send an email confirmation to the customer with screenshots of the exams our team sets up.

Can the Saunders Online Modules be done at home? Modules are not proctored and can be completed at home or on campus. They are similar to a homework assignment.
