Utilize HESI Exams

These are an ideal way to test content knowledge throughout the nursing program and prepare your students for the NCLEX! Each course has 1-2 versions of a HESI Specialty Exam available.

Go through HESI Case Studies Together

These can be used as in class discussion activities, as part of a clinical post conference activity, or as a way to bring a real world patient scenario to skills lab. We recommend using these at least 3 times in each course.

Create NCLEX EAQs for Your Students to use to Practice

We recommend creating and assigning a 50 item Custom Quiz in the content area of focus for students to use as practice before the HESI Exam. Consider creating an additional custom quiz for extra practice!

Give Students a Digital Clincal Experience with Shadow Health

Use these assignments for synchronous or asynchronous learning, lab or clinical preparation, or for clinical hour replacement. These are a great way to help students get more out of clinical and classroom time!

Incorporate an NGN Case Study into Class

You can use Sherpath, EAQ NCLEX, EAB, and text resources to find NGN cases, or create your own in EAB. Utilizing cases in this way allows students to work through the scenario in a low stakes way, while providing you with an opportunity to assess their critical thinking and clinical judgement skills.

Assign Sherpath Lessons

Assign 2-3 lessons per week. If you are covering many chapters in a week, assign 1 lesson per chapter. Prioritize lessons:

- from HESI focused chapters
- with Osmosis videos in them
- covering difficult concepts

Utilize Sherpath EAQs

Use both custom and mastery quizzing to cover all of your weekly content. Prioritize HESI focused chapters for mastery quizzing, and create a custom quiz to cover the rest of the content.
