Getting Started

To get started using Shadow Health's Digital Clinical Experiences (DCEs) in Sherpath Vantage, there are a few basic steps you will need to complete:

- 1. Adding assignments
- 2. Enabling assignment settings
- 3. Accessing student results

These 3 key steps are essential to successfully setting up and navigating your course, ensuring you and your students are set up for success.

Add Assignments

Shadow Health assignments must be added and made visible after you have created your Sherpath Vantage course. You can add your Shadow Health assignments via the resources tab, navigational panel, and directly from your Course Plan.

Enable Settings

To set up your Shadow Health assignments, there are two types of settings you will need to enable: basic and advanced. Basic settings must be set before the advanced settings can be enabled.

Basic Settings

These settings will include the same settings you can enable for your other Sherpath assignments including assignment name, availability, assign to, and grading.

Advanced Settings

These settings are specific to Shadow Health and allow you to customize the assignments to best fit your students' learning needs. The advanced settings include reopening, the interview guide, and a care plan, and can be accessed by clicking the "Advanced Settings" button in the lower-right corner of the Assignment Settings page.

Reopening

Allows students to return to the patient's room to ask more questions or perform a more thorough exam, with all their previous work saved.

Interview Guide

Provides students with additional help collecting subjective data during patient encounters, outlining the key topics to cover in their interviews.

Care Plan

After the patient exams, students will use the data they have collected to create short-term care plans and choose appropriate interventions.

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Review Student Results

You can access your students' results in two places: the Student Results Book in Shadow Health and the Sherpath Performance and Grades Dashboard in your Vantage course.

Student Results Book

To view student results in the Shadow Health Gradebook, click the "Scored" or "Not Graded" link in your course plan – this will take you to the Shadow health gradebook where you can view your class DCE scores. Click the status link to view individual student results and detailed immediate feedback.





Performance and Grades Dashboard

To view student results via Sherpath, you can use the Performance and Grades Dashboard.

Like other scored Sherpath assignments, Shadow health will show up in its own category in the gradebook tab in the Performance Dashboard once the due date has passed. By default, you'll see their overall score at a glance. You can expand the Shadow Health tab for more detailed scoring.

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Strategies for Success

To ensure an effective learning experience, there are a few strategies we recommend for successful integration as you get started.

Try the Assignments as a Student

We recommend trying at least one assignment yourself before assigning it to students to understand your learners' Shadow Health experience, especially if you are new to the product.

You can try any assignment as a student after adding it to your Course Plan. Once added, click the assignment's name then select the "Try As Student" button in the upper-right corner of the Assignment Overview. This will also allow you to see how the assignment is automatically scored, in addition to the detailed immediate feedback.



Require Orientation Assignments

The DCE Orientation, Conversation Concept Lab, and Communication and Documentation Tutorials are designed to introduce your students to how Shadow Health works and prepare them for scored assessments. Assigning these activities will ensure your students are comfortable navigating and using the Shadow Health interface.

Use a DCE Score Threshold

Use the DCE score as a threshold for grading your Shadow Health assignments. Many faculty require a minimum DCE score to receive credit for the assignments to ensure students are performing at a level that demonstrates competency.
