
Sherpath: Performance Reports – Lesson Assignments

NOTE: Depending upon the Sherpath collection you are using, the modules will be arranged either by topics or by book chapters.

Performance Reports – Lesson Assignments

- 1. First, access Sherpath from your course.
- 2. Use the calendar link in the upper-right corner to navigate to the week when the Lesson was due.
- 3. The Lesson will be listed under the Assignments list near the top of the page.
 - a. To the right of the Lesson, you will see a number indicating the number of students who have not completed the assignment. Click on the number to see the names of the students who did not complete the assignment.

4. To the far right, you will see a link to access the Lesson's Performance Report.


This link will be greyed out until the due date passes.



5. Once the due date passes, the link turns blue. The report is now available, and the link will become active.




6. After clicking the link to view the Performance Report, you will see your students' class average listed.



7. Next, you will see the Incomplete section which lists the students who have not completed the assignment and the percentage of the assignment they have currently completed.




8. You can also see your students' lowest performing topic and their average grade for that topic, along with the topic they spent the most time on.




9. On the Average Performance by Topic table, you will see the students' average score and time spent for each individual topic in the assignment.


NOTE: These percentages can include data from repeated attempts if your students completed the assignments more than once.



10. Individual Student Scores will be listed along with their submission time and time spent on the assignment.



- 11. The final section lists the students' top missed questions with the students' average score for the question.
- 12. This information can include data from repeated attempts at the assignment. All tables on this page can be resorted by clicking the **blue column headings.**
