


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Adding External Links in Sherpath

As an instructor, you may have already curated online videos and resources for your students' specific learning needs. Perhaps you've created a slide deck you'd like your students to review before class. In addition to the wealth of clinical and content resources available to you in Sherpath, you can further customize your course by adding an external link to an online resource of your choice.



Determine the web address of the external link you'd like to add to your Course Plan. You will copy and paste this into the text bar of your Resource Link.





On the left-hand side under Add More Resources, select Add External Link, and a new window will appear. Paste the web address you've copied into the empty text bar. Type in the text you would like to have displayed this is what students will see in their Course Plan - and choose the availability date.





Once you have saved these settings, you will then be prompted to select where you'd like the link to appear. You should now see the link when you return to the Course Plan.
