#### **Access Instructions**

Welcome to SLS with VR! The following step-by-step instructions will outline how to use the web browser via your Quest 2 to access the orientation video in your VR headset.

#### Navigate to the VR Browser Instructions

- 1. Power on your Quest 2 and put on your headset
- 2. Use the Oculus toolbar at the bottom of your Home screen to open the App Library
  - a. If your toolbar does not populate automatically, click the Oculus button on the right controller to launch it
- 3. Select the "Web Browser" app **NOTE:** The "Web Browser" app icon may look like a globe

#### Access the Orientation Video

- 1. After the browser launches, click the address bar at the top
  - a. A virtual on-screen keyboard will populate, allowing you to enter a web address
- 2. Enter the following URL: rebrand.ly/SLSVR
  - a. Use the controller to direct your aim around the keyboard
  - b. Use the trigger button to select letters, numbers, or any other characters on the keyboard
- 3. Click the "go" button on the keyboard to submit
  - a. A webpage titled "SLS with VR Orientation" will load

### Adjust the Video Settings and Play

- 1. After the webpage loads, adjust the settings as follows before watching the video for the best VR viewing experience
  - a. First, press play to generate the full screen button **NOTE:** We recommend momentarily pausing the video immediately to allow you to enable the settings without interruption
  - b. Click the square button in the lower right corner of the video to enable full screen
    - i. After you enable full screen, a new in-VR toolbar will populate towards the bottom of the video with the following options (from left to right):
      - 1. Left section: Exit or enter full screen/immersive, volume
      - 2. Right section: VR view setting, VR dimension setting
  - c. The VR view will be set to "Non-VR" by default, click "Non-VR" to the right of the in-VR toolbar and select "VR 360" to change the view setting, activating the immersive experience

**NOTE:** "VR 360" is the recommended VR view setting

- d. The VR dimension will be set to 2D by default, which should be left as-is **NOTE:** We do not recommended switching from 2D to 3D
- e. Click the play button in the middle of the video to begin watchingi. To relaunch the in-VR toolbar at any time, press the trigger button
- f. Feel free to look around and immerse yourself in the virtual environment!

- 2. To exit the immersive experience, click the square with four arrows pointing inward in the left section of the in-VR toolbar
  - a. You can also change the VR view setting to "Non-VR" to exit the immersive experience
- 3. To disable full screen after exiting the immersive experience, click the square with four arrows pointing inward in the left section of the in-VR toolbar
  - a. You can also click the full screen button in the browser in the lower left corner of the video
- 4. To exit the browser, click the Oculus button on your right controller

#### Tips and Tricks

Review these tips and tricks for easy browser navigation and a consistent viewing experience.

#### **Browser Navigation and Settings**

- You can open additional tabs or windows in the browser to load the video, if desired
  - To open a new tab, select the plus button near the upper left section of the toolbar in your current browser window
  - To open a new browser window, select the plus button hovering above the middle of your current browser window
- You can bookmark the video in the browser for easy access, if desired
  - To add a new bookmark, select the bookmark icon in the upper right section of the toolbar
  - To access or manage your bookmarks, click the settings button (3 vertical dots) in the upper right corner of your browser then "Bookmarks"
    - Click the title of the bookmark to launch the webpage
    - Click the settings button to the right of the bookmark to edit or remove it

#### Video Navigation and Settings

- We highly recommend watching the video in full screen, using the VR 360 and 2D settings
  - The VR 180 view can be used for a less comprehensive view and visually the video dimensions will be more single-screen oriented
  - If the VR 360 setting is too intense, utilizing the default, "Non-VR" setting will provide a less stimulating viewing experience
  - We do not recommend switching to the 3D setting because it can be very disorienting and negatively alter the proportions of the video
- The volume can be adjusted in the web browser, in the primary headset settings, and manually on the headset
  - To adjust the volume in the web browser, use the volume slider in the VR toolbar
  - To adjust the volume in the primary headset settings, open the Oculus toolbar at the bottom of your screen and click the settings gear
    - Select the "Quick Settings" tab on the left, if it does not populate automatically
    - Use the volume slider in the upper left section to edit as desired
  - To adjust the volume on the headset manually, locate the volume rocker under the front of your headset to the right (near the power button)
    - Press the "minus" button on the left to decrease the volume
    - Press the "plus" button on the right to increase the volume
