## **Evolve Link: Adding Evolve Content to Moodle**

**Introduction:** Evolve Link allows for linking to Evolve content through a Learning Management System (LMS). Evolve Link must be configured by the LMS Administrator prior to adding Evolve content to a course.

**Purpose:** This document walks through adding Evolve content into Moodle through Evolve Link.

## Accessing Evolve Link

1. Once in the desired Moodle course, click Turn editing on.



2. Click **Add activity or resource** under the desired section.



3. Click the radio button next to the **Evolve Link** external tool.

**NOTE:** If you don't see Evolve Link, contact your LMS Administrator to get the tool added to Moodle for your institution.

4. Click Add.



5. Provide a name for the **external tool [Evolve Link]**.




6. Click Save and return to course.


**NOTE:** This link needs to be hidden from students.



- 7. Click Edit next to Evolve Link.
- 8. Click Hide.




9. Click on the newly created **Evolve Link**.



10. This opens your instance of Evolve. On the My Content list, find the product in which you want to link.

**NOTE:** You can either link to the Main content library or you can create links to individual items or folders within each product by clicking on the product name and finding the item or folder to which you want to link.

11. Click Create Link next to the desired product or content.



## 12. Click Copy URL.



- 13. Return to Moodle.
- 14. Click **Add an activity or resource** under the desired section.






- 15. Click External tool.
- 16. Click Add.



- 17. Complete the following steps to Add the External tool:
  - a) Add the Activity name [Chapter 1].
  - b) Paste the copied URL into the *Tool URL* field.
  - c) Click Save and return to course.



18. Click the link [Chapter 1] to ensure its accuracy.



19. The correct Evolve Content opens.
