

Creating Graded Evolve Assignments in Moodle

Introduction: This guide will walk you through creating graded assignments in Moodle.

NOTE: There are 4 types of products that have assignments that can be linked to Moodle using these steps: **Clinical Skills, Elsevier Adaptive Learning**, and select versions of **Evolve Resources, and Online Courses**. In Evolve resources and online courses the only assignments that will pass directly to the gradebook will be inside of a folder marked as gradable resources.

External Tool Setup

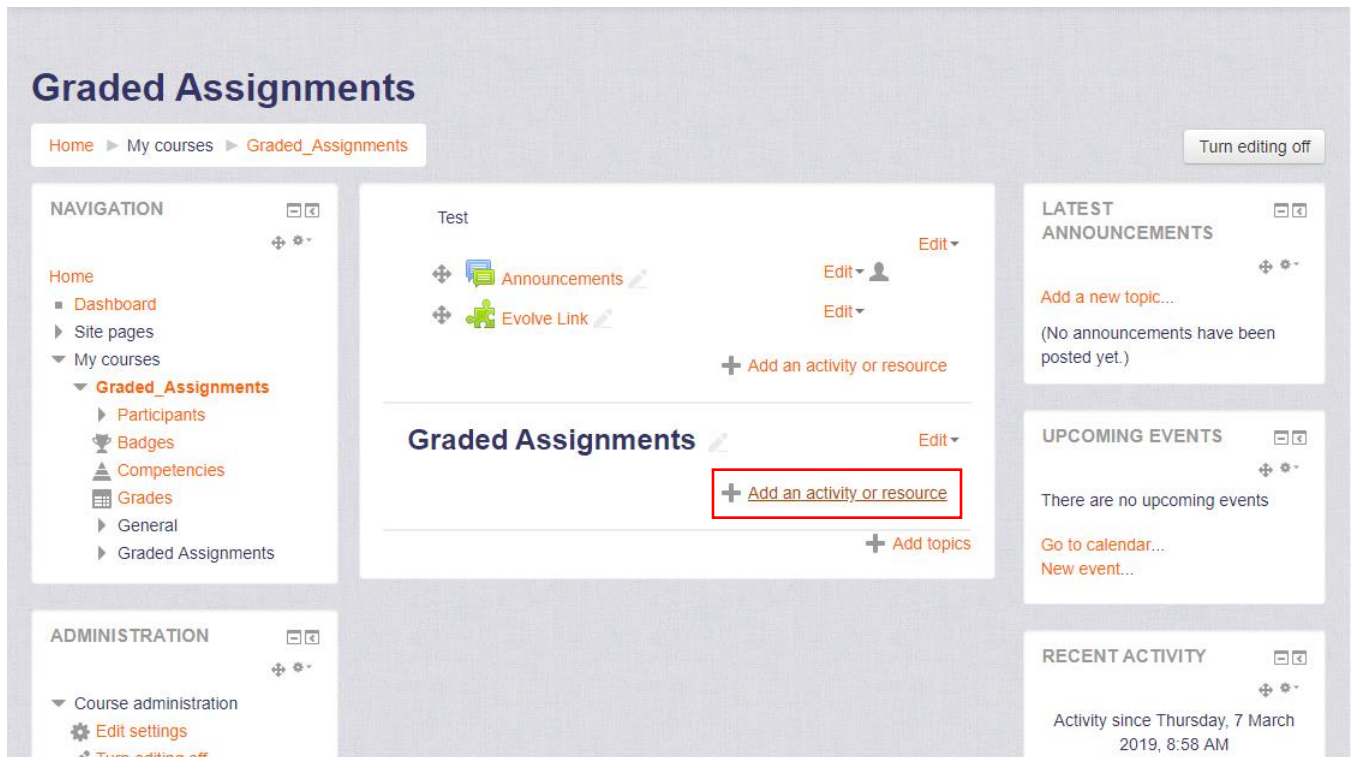
1. Login to Moodle and go to your desired course.
2. Click **Turn editing on** and open **Evolve Link** in a new tab.

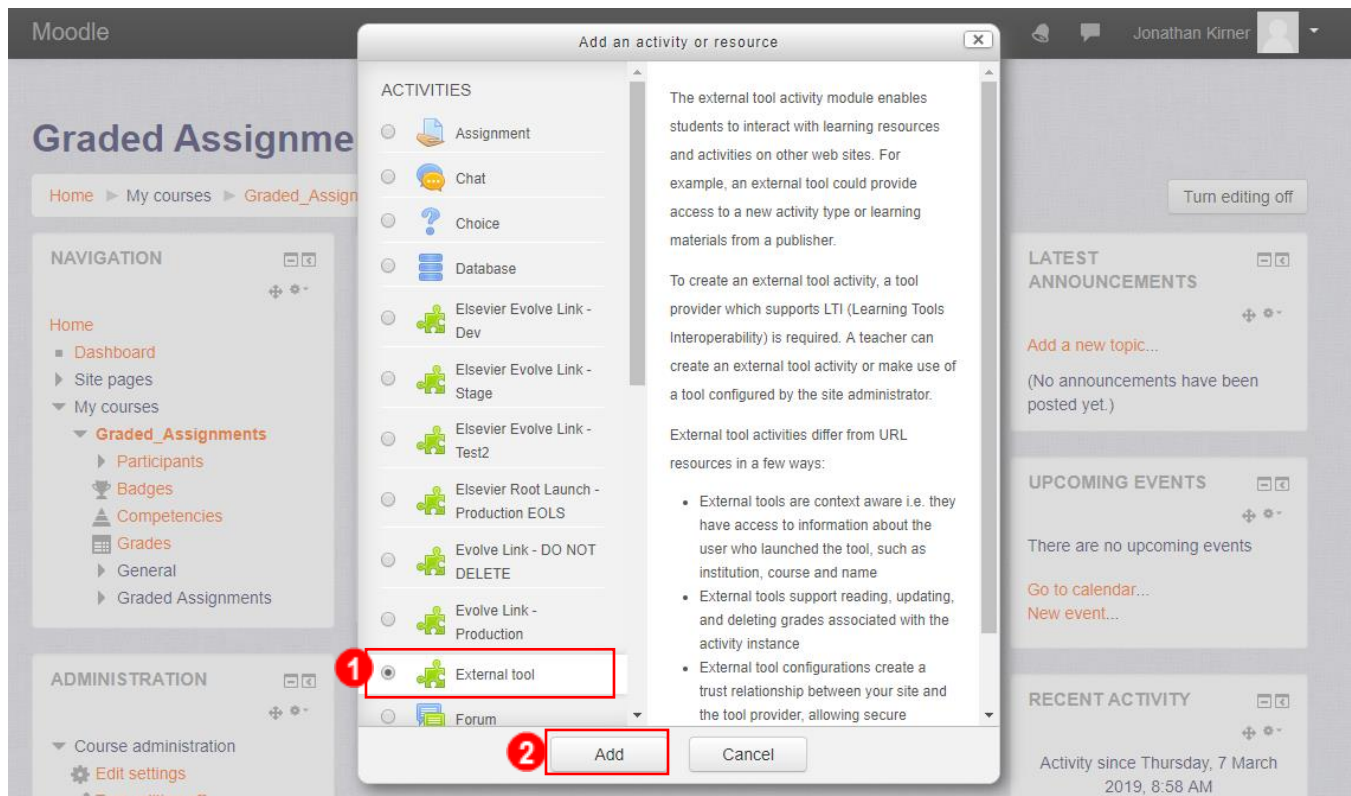

3. In the Moodle tab, click **Add an activity or resource**.







4. Choose External Tool and click Add.



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5. In the Evolve Link tab click on the **title** of the resource you are pulling the assignment from.

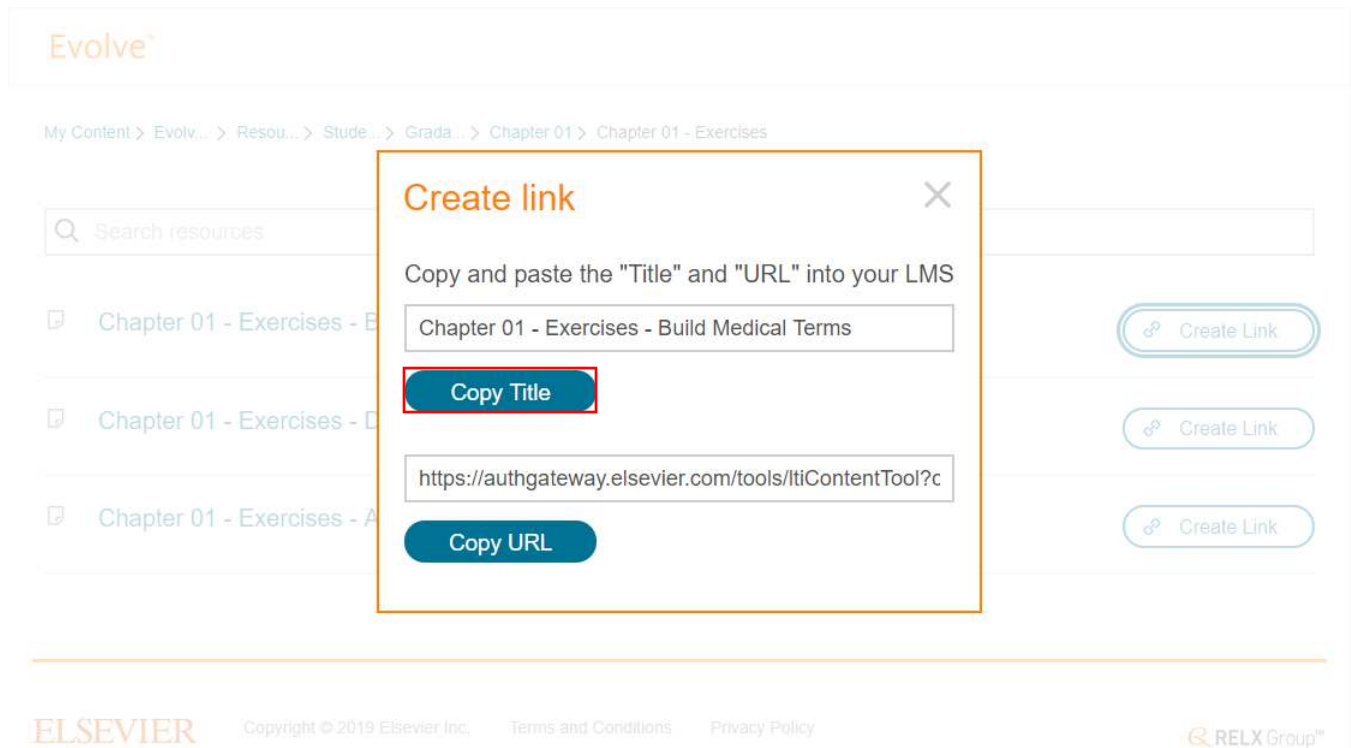

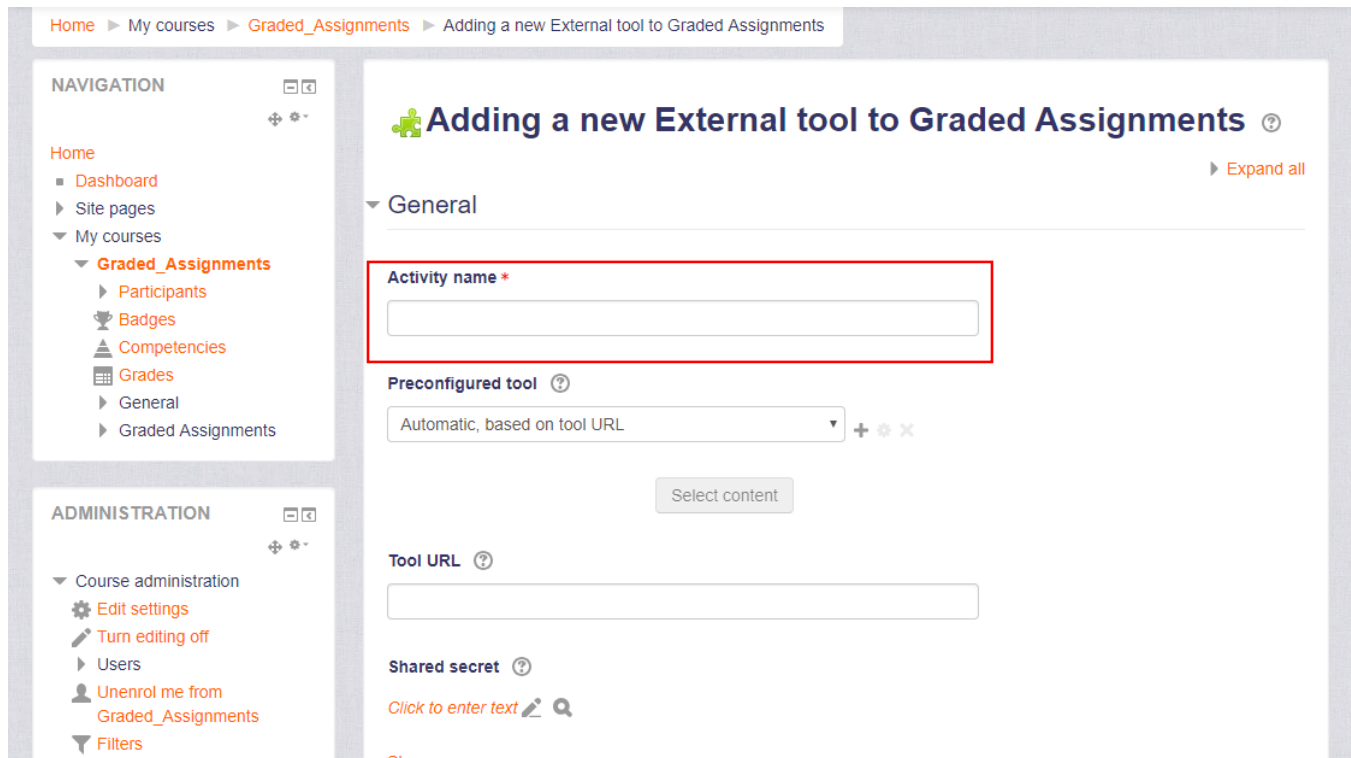

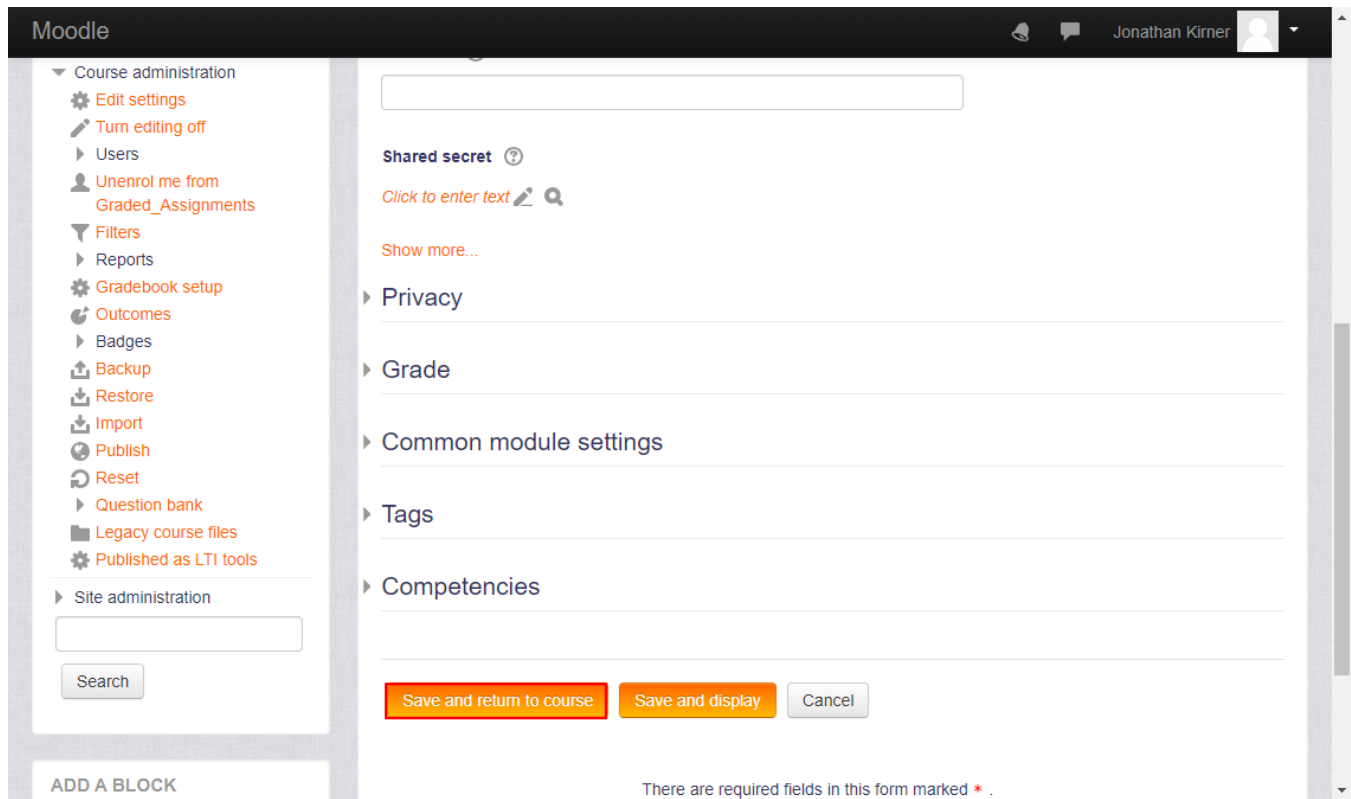
